I run this program almost entirely by myself. I say 'almost' because as Showcase draws near, people step forward to offer assistance.

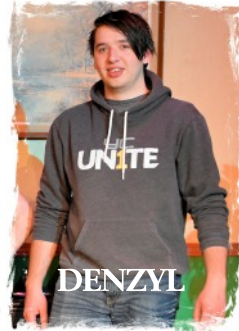
